Ox-PAQ Update: The quarterly newsletter of the Ox-PAQ Initiative

Welcome to the tenth edition of *Ox-PAQ Update*. News from the last three months is given below:

- We have now received ethical approval for the first stage of Ox-PAQ Phase Two, which involves conducting a small number of cognitive interviews to assess the usability and acceptability of an e-based version of the Ox-PAQ. An ethics application for the electronic survey that will follow is currently being prepared.
- Our manuscript detailing the psychometric analysis of the Ox-PAQ has been submitted for publication to the open access journal *Patient Related Outcome Measures*. Details on the progress of the article will be provided in our next newsletter.
- An Ox-PAQ user manual is currently being drafted. This will be available for distribution once the psychometric analysis has been accepted for publication.
- Our second Ox-PAQ abstract for 2015 will be presented at the 22nd World Congress of Neurology, which takes place in Santiago, Chile in November. The abstract will be published in *Journal of the Neurological Sciences*. A full reference and link will be provided in our next newsletter.
- A third Ox-PAQ abstract for 2015 has been accepted for presentation at the 18th Annual European Congress of the International Society for Pharmacoeconomics and Outcomes Research (ISPOR), which is taking place in Milan, Italy, also in November of this year. The abstract will be published in the journal *Value in Health*. A full reference and link will be provided in our next newsletter.
- As reported in our previous newsletter, a lay summary of the project, outlining key statistics and results from both the development and validation stages, is available on the HSRU website.
