Welcome to the thirteenth edition of *Ox-PAQ Update*. News from the last three months is given below:

 Our manuscript detailing the psychometric analysis of the Ox-PAQ has been published by the open access journal *Patient Related Outcome Measures*.

- An e-based survey to assess the sensitivity to change of the Ox-PAQ commenced at the beginning of April. To date we have recruited 337 participants, of which 262 have completed their first administration of the Ox-PAQ. Once again, our thanks go to the following organisations for their assistance with participant recruitment: British Lung Foundation, Motor Neurone Disease Association, Multiple Sclerosis Society and Parkinson's UK.
- Our first Ox-PAQ abstract of 2016 has recently been presented at the 2nd Congress of the European Academy of Neurology which took place in Copenhagen, Denmark. The abstract has been published in the European Journal of Neurology and can be viewed at the following link:
