

## Ox-PAQ Update: The quarterly newsletter of the Ox-PAQ Initiative

Welcome to the fourteenth edition of *Ox-PAQ Update*. News from the last three months is given below:

- The first phase of our e-based survey to assess the sensitivity to change of the Ox-PAQ will close on 30<sup>th</sup> September. To date we have recruited 462 participants, of which 364 have completed their first administration of the Ox-PAQ. The second phase will begin early in October and participant numbers will again be reported via *Ox-PAQ Update*. As ever, our thanks go to the following organisations for their assistance with participant recruitment: British Lung Foundation, Motor Neurone Disease Association, Multiple Sclerosis Society and Parkinson's UK.
- A manuscript detailing additional psychometric analyses of the Ox-PAQ has recently been submitted for publication in the open-access journal *Health* and Quality of Life Outcomes. The manuscript is currently undergoing peerreview. Details of any further progress will be provided in our next newsletter.
- Our second abstract for 2016 will be presented at the 23<sup>rd</sup> Annual Conference of the International Society for Quality of Life Research (ISOQOL), which takes place in October in Copenhagen, Denmark. The abstract is to be published in a supplement of the journal *Quality of Life Research*. A full reference and link to the abstract will be provided in our next newsletter.
- A third and final abstract for this year has been accepted for presentation at the International Society for Pharmacoeconomics and Outcomes Research (ISPOR) 19<sup>th</sup> Annual European Congress, which is being held in Vienna, Austria from 29<sup>th</sup> October to 2<sup>nd</sup> November. The abstract will be published in a supplement of the journal *Value in Health*. A full reference and link to the abstract will be provided in our next newsletter.
- We are currently considering Ox-PAQ dissemination options for 2017 and have shortlisted the following international conferences:
  - 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual International Meeting of ISPOR, May 2017, Boston, USA.

Final decisions as to which of these conferences will be attended will be made over the coming months.
