

## Ox-PAQ Update: The quarterly newsletter of the Ox-PAQ Initiative

Welcome to the ninth edition of *Ox-PAQ Update*. News from the last three months is given below:

- The survey phase of the project closed on 31<sup>st</sup> March. A total of 365 participants completed our postal survey with 265 also participating in the test-retest process. Ox-PAQ data has now been subject to psychometric analyses, with results indicating a valid and reliable 23-item measure. These results are currently being prepared for publication and, once published, will be available for distribution.
- Our manuscript detailing the item generation process for the Ox-PAQ has been published by the open access journal *Patient Related Outcome* Measures. The full reference is as follows:

- A third Ox-PAQ abstract has been submitted for presentation at the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual European Congress of the International Society for Pharmacoeconomics and Outcomes Research (ISPOR), which is taking place in Milan, Italy in November of this year. Acceptance notification is due at the end of July.
- A lay summary of the project, outlining key statistics and results from both the development and validation stages, has now been produced. The summary is available on the HSRU and EBC websites and has been mailed to 66 participants who specifically requested the summary by post.
