

Ox-PAQ Update: The quarterly newsletter of the Ox-PAQ Initiative

Welcome to the seventh edition of *Ox-PAQ Update*. News from the last three months is given below:

- The survey phase of the project is well underway and will run until the end of March. We currently have 399 participants recruited and have received 294 completed survey booklets. The test-retest procedure has also been well supported by participants, with 239 so far agreeing to complete the Ox-PAQ for a second time. To date, we have received 137 test-retest responses. We are, as ever, hugely grateful to the following organisations for their support in recruiting participants: Floura Health Care, Macmillan Cancer, MND Association, MS Society, Spinal Injuries Association and Parkinson's UK.
- In addition to our main survey, the Ox-PAQ has been incorporated into the OxVALVE study. This population cohort study is based in Oxfordshire and has two aims. Firstly, to identify people with valvular heart disease (VHD) and thereby establish its incidence within the population. Secondly, through further investigation, the researchers hope to develop improved treatment strategies for VHD. The study should generate important validation data for the Ox-PAQ and will be combined with data from the main Ox-PAQ survey. Further details of OxVALVE can be found at the following link:
