Professor Casadei is based at the John Radcliffe Hospital and leads the Myocardial Redox Biology group. Her long-standing focus has been to explore the hypothesis that targeting nitric oxide and reactive oxygen species may open new therapeutic avenues for cardiovascular disease.

In parallel with her mechanistic work on human cardiac tissue and animal models, she has collaborated with CTSU and FuWai Hospital to recently complete the ‘Statin Therapy in Cardiac Surgery’ (STICS trial)
