## Professor Carol Brayne

Professor of Public Health Medicine  
University of Cambridge



**Carol Brayne** is Professor of Public Health Medicine in the Dept of Public Health & Primary Care in the *University of Cambridge*. She is a medically qualified epidemiologist & public health academic. She graduated in medicine from the *Royal Free Hospital School of Medicine* & went on to train in general medicine. After gaining membership she moved on to training in epidemiology with a Training Fellowship (on ageing & dementia) with the *Medical Research Council*.

Since the mid eighties her main research area has been longitudinal studies of older people following changes over time in cognition, dementia natural history & associated features with a public health perspective. She is lead principal investigator in the group of MRC CFA Studies which have informed & will continue to inform national policy & scientific understanding of dementia in whole populations. She has been responsible for training programmes in epidemiology & public health for under & postgraduates since the early nineties. She is Director of the **Cambridge Institute of Public Health** at the University of Cambridge.
