### Professor Cathie Sudlow



UK Biobank is an open-access prospective study of 500,000 participants, recruited and extensively phenotyped from 2006-2010 at the age of 40-69, and now being followed up for the occurrence of a range of health-related outcomes.

As UK Biobank's Chief Scientist, Professor Sudlow leads the follow-up programme, coordinating linkages to national death, cancer, hospital, primary care and other datasets, and nine expert outcomes adjudication subgroups (cancer, diabetes, cardiac, stroke, neurodegenerative, mental health, musculoskeletal, respiratory, ocular outcomes).

In this seminar, Professor Sudlow will report on recent progress and highlight upcoming research opportunities.
