## Prof Harry Hemingway



Professor Hemingway's research focuses on cardiovascular disease. Broadly the aim is to generate new research evidence at multiple stages in the translational pathways for improving our understanding of why cardiovascular diseases occurs and then progresses, in ways which can have an impact on clinical practice, healthcare and public health policy.

A key element of the approach of his work is to exploit new opportunities for large scale research arising from linking electronic health records. He is principal investigator of the CALIBRE research platform which has linked together the General Practice Research Database, Hospital Episode Statistics, the Myocardial Infarction National Audit Project with Office of National Statistics mortality/social deprivation data.
