

## Professor Jack Cuzick

Professor Jack Cuzick is head of the Centre for Cancer Prevention in London, and John Snow Professor of Epidemiology at the Wolfson Institute of Preventive Medicine at Queen Mary, University of London. He holds a PhD in Mathematics and has previously worked at Oxford and Columbia Universities. His current interests are in cancer epidemiology and clinical trials, with special interest in prevention and screening. He is currently Chairman of the International Breast Cancer Intervention Study (IBIS) Steering Group, the Independent Statistician for the ATAC trial and is also involved in studies on the use of HPV assays for cervical screening, the use of flexible sigmoidoscopy for colorectal cancer screening and markers for the behaviour of early prostate cancer. Prof Cuzick is the statistician for several major breast cancer trials and maintains an active interest in developing new statistical methodology, especially in the area of adjustments for non-compliance and cross-over, and multi-arm clinical trials. He is President of the International Society of Cancer Prevention and is a Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences, the Royal Statistical Society, the Institute of Mathematical Statistics and an Honorary Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians.
