Dr John Chambers is a Reader in Cardiovascular Epidemiology in the School of Public Health at *Imperial College London* and Consultant Cardiologist at *Ealing Hospital & Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust*.

Dr Chambers' research focuses on the investigation of genetic and environmental mechanisms underlying obesity, diabetes, cardiovascular disease and related phenotypic disturbances in Indian Asians. Working closely with Professor Jaspal S. Kooner, Professor Paul Elliott, Professor James Scott and others, he established the **London Life Sciences Prospective Population Study (LOLIPOP)**, one of the largest cohort studies of Indian Asians worldwide.
