Professor Lucilla Poston is Head of the Division of Women's Health in the School of Medicine at **King's College London**, and research lead in Women's Health for the King's Health Partners Academic Health Sciences Centre. She graduated in Physiology from **University College London**, and undertook her PhD at King's College London. Her research team focus on pre-eclampsia, obesity in pregnancy and the developmental origins of disease.

Professor Poston is a Fellow *ad eundem* of the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists, a Senior Investigator (UK) of the National Institute for Health Research, and Fellow of the Academy of Medical Sciences (UK). She has published more than 250 original research papers.
