## **Mr Matt Bown**

Senior Lecturer in Surgery,

University of Leicester



After training in surgery in Cardiff, Leicester and Liverpool Mr Bown was appointed as Senior Lecturer in Surgery at the University of Leicester in 2010, where he is involved in a continuing research programme investigating the pathogenesis of abdominal aortic aneurysms.

The majority of his research involves the application of post-genomic experimental approaches to these subject areas, and he currently leads a worldwide collaboration, 'The Aneurysm Consortium' which was formed for the purposes of conducting a genome-wide association study of abdominal aortic aneurysm, funded by The Wellcome Trust. He also has an interest in evidence synthesis, and he continues to work clinically as a Consultant Vascular Surgeon.
