Peter Whincup is Professor of Epidemiology in the Division of Population Health Sciences at St George's, University of London. He is a clinically trained epidemiologist with interests in the epidemiology and prevention of cardiovascular disease and type 2 diabetes. He is particularly interested in ethnic, geographic and social variations in these conditions, and in the emergence of chronic disease risks over the life course.

He is clinical director of the British Regional Heart Study and the Child Heart and Health Study in England (CHASE Study).
