Raghiv Ali is the Director of the *INDOX Cancer Research Network*, which he has led since its establishment in 2005, and a Clinical Epidemiologist at the Cancer Epidemiology Unit at the University of Oxford. He is also an Honorary Consultant in Acute Medicine at the John Radcliffe Hospital in Oxford and the Richard Doll Medical Tutorial Fellow at Green-Templeton College.

He graduated in Medicine from the University of Cambridge in 1999 where he was awarded the *John Addenbrooke's prize for Medicine*. He completed his clinical training in General (Internal) Medicine & Clinical Pharmacology in 2009. He also has an MSc in Epidemiology from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine.

His main research interests are the aetiology, prevention and treatment of non-communicable diseases in South Asian and Middle Eastern populations. He is the principal investigator for a number of clinical trials and epidemiological studies in the UK, India and the United Arab Emirates.
