Prof Dame Valerie Beral & Kath Moser

Professor Dame Valerie Beral is Professor of Epidemiology at the University of Oxford and, since 1989, has been Director of the Cancer Epidemiology Unit (CEU) in Oxford. After studying medicine at Sydney University, Professor Beral undertook clinical work in Australia, New Guinea and the UK and spent almost 20 years working in the Department of Epidemiology at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. She is Principal Investigator for the Million Women Study on the effect of women's lifestyle on health, with particular focus on the effects of hormone replacement therapy, and she leads international collaborative studies of breast, ovarian and endometrial cancer.



Kath Moser is Senior Researcher in the CEU in Oxford and is a co-investigator and co-ordinator of the England-wide NHS Breast Screening Programme Age Extension Trial. She is also an investigator on the Collaborative Group on Epidemiological Studies of Ovarian Cancer. Before joining CEU

she worked at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine and the Office for National Statistics. Her research interests are wide, span high- and low- and middle- income countries, and include the social determinants of health, infant and child mortality, and the epidemic of non-communicable disease in Africa and Asia.
