Liam Smeeth is Professor of Clinical Epidemiology, and Head of the Department of Non-Communicable Disease Epidemiology at the *London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine*. He also undertakes clinical work as a general practitioner in north London. Much of his research is based on making better use of computerised clinical data both to investigate drug effects and disease aetiology.

He holds a Wellcome Trust Senior Fellowship in Clinical Science and is Deputy Director of the *Farr Institute London*, one of the four UK Health Informatics Research Centres. His broad interests include disease aetiology, drug effects, genetics and non-communicable diseases in low income settings. He is involved in a range of activities for the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence and the National Health Service more widely.
